Terms & Conditions

1.	All dogs must pass our standard induction assessment, should your dog be deemed inappropriate (e.g. behaviour, health etc) by staff at any time, your dog may be excluded and no longer able to attend Cain9 Camp.
2.	For safety reasons All dogs must wear a quick release collar with an identification tag with the dog's name and owners contact details and must be microchipped. Please keep your dog on a lead at all times when arriving and leaving Cain9 Camp
3.	I acknowledge and accept that by attending Cain9 Camp, my dog will be interacting with dogs of different breeds, sizes, age and gender. All dog play is carefully monitored to avoid injury, but scratches, punctures, torn ligaments, or other injury's may occur despite best supervision. Should my dog sustain such an injury, I acknowledge that all treatment will be at my sole discretion and cost.
4.	I understand and agree that should any significant behavioural or health problem occur with my dog whilst at Cain9 Camp, staff will carry out a cursory examination and decide on the most appropriate course of action which may include treatment at the veterinary clinic closest to Cain9 Camp (County Vets Sandbach). We will endeavour to contact you immediately. By signing this document, I direct my own vet to provide medical records upon request to support such treatment. I will assume full financial responsibility for all expenses involved and will settle directly with County Vets Sandbach. Any subsequent treatment will be at my discretion and cost.
5.	Cain9 Camp will not be held liable to the injury, disappearance, death or fines accrued by any dog in their care unless falling under the requirement for public liability insurance. I agree that it is my responsibility, to ensure my dog has adequate insurance in respect of any injuries received from, or caused to other dogs or persons whilst in the care of Cain9 Camp.
6.	DHPP vaccinations must be up to date and copies provided. I understand that even if my dog is vaccinated for Bordetella (Kennel Cough) there is a chance that my dog can still contract Kennel Cough. I agree that I will not hold Cain9 Camp responsible if my dog contracts Kennel Cough while attending Cain9 Camp.
7.	I agree to notify Cain9 Camp of any infectious and/or contagious disease or conditions my dog has been exposed to/or is affected by; including but not limited to; distemper, hepatitis, kennel cough, parvovirus, worms, fleas, pregnancy, skin disease and intestinal parasites. I will report to Cain9 Camp if my dog contracts such a disease and accept that my dog will not be allowed to attend Cain9 Camp until the condition is resolved and signed off by a vet, regardless of days booked.
8.	All male dogs over the age of 8 months should be castrated, younger male dogs that develop inappropriate hormonal behaviour before 8 months may also be suspended form Cain9 Camp unless an agreement is made otherwise
9.	Bitches who come into season will not be able to attend for the duration of their season, usually 2 to 3 weeks, Cain9 Camp will not take responsibility for bitches who are sent into day care while still in season.
10.	Cain9 Camp is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged toys, leads, collars, tags, clothing or any item left with my dog.
11.	All dogs must be in good physical health to attend Cain9 Camp. Should Cain9 Camp be asked to administer medication, full written consent and instructions must be given to staff, all medicines need to be in their original packaging.
12.	I agree to manage my dog's food intake before arrival at Cain9 Camp, so he/she has time to digest his/her food before excitement begins. I understand that failure to do so may result in bloat, which is very dangerous.
13.	Only dogs considered to be well socialised are suitable for day care please note not all dogs are suitable. We do not accept any dogs listed in the dangerous dog's act 1997 or any strong jawed dogs e.g. Staffordshire terrier, German Shepherd
14.	Payment must be given the day before to secure your place, no refunds will be given for early pick up. Cain9 Camp is open Monday to Friday 8.00am until 6.00pm. Please notify us by phone if you are going to be late, every 30 minutes you are late an additional £5.00 will be added to your bill. After 6.30pm your dog can only be collected at a time convenient to us.
15.	Should you wish to cancel your booking 24 hours notice is required, fees will not be refunded for cancellations made without 24 hours notice.
16.	Flea policy – dogs found to have fleas will automatically be treated and the owner charged and extra £15
17.	I agree to my dog being photographed, filmed and used in any media or advertising without prior approval from me. All such photographs, etc remain the property of Cain9 Camp. I agree Cain9 Camp can send me text/emails in regard to the new GDPR rules.
18.	I agree that my personal details, normal vet details and insurance details can be given to County Vets Sandbach in any emergency so I can be contacted, and my dog can be treated appropriately.

Each of the foregoing provisions are separate and shall be in force and effect on each and every occasion my dog attends Cain9 Camp. This statement shall remain in full force until and unless otherwise amended or revoked, cancelled or suspended in writing signed by both parties.

I confirm that I understand and agree to abide by the terms and conditions set out above.

<b><u>Other:</u></b> Dogs under 12 months of age do have their own section in daycare if we feel they were to need more rest time and socialisation on a smaller level. No bitches on heat can attend daycare.
